- _____ Massachusetts: American elm
- _____ Maryland: white oak
- _____ New Hampshire: white birch
- _____ Virginia: flowering dogwood*
(kousa dogwood)
- _____ New York: sugar maple
- _____ Rhode Island: red maple

- _____ Georgia: southern live oak* (bur oak)
- _____ South Carolina: sabal palm*
- _____ North Carolina: pine* (pitch pine)
